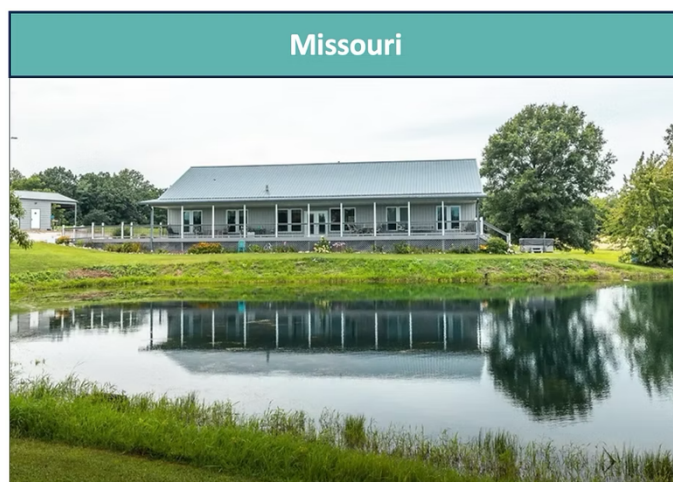
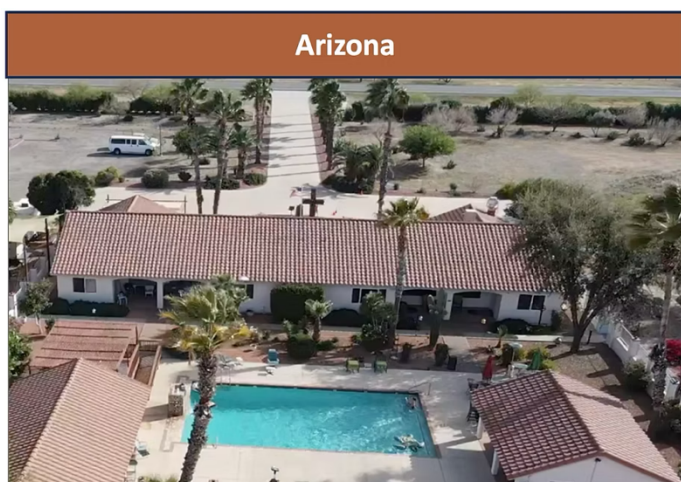
Milestone: Over 1,000 SCR participants!

Since Shepherd's Canyon began in 2009, God has allowed us to host more than **150 counseling retreats** and serve more than **1,000 pastors, ministry workers, and spouses. Praise God!**

An EXCITING Opportunity to Double Your Gift!!!

Let's get it done!!! Here's an opportunity to double your gift! In 2020, Founder Dave Anderson helped raise nearly \$300,000 for the construction of a new lodge at our Arizona retreat center. Unfortunately, the project was delayed by COVID-19, permitting challenges, and necessary design changes. In those 6 years, **construction costs have nearly doubled.** We now need to raise an additional \$300,000 so this building can become a reality.

We are excited to announce that **generous donors** have offered to **match gifts totaling up to \$150,000!** Another donor has already pledged \$20,000 toward the match, so now we are looking to you to help us raise another **\$130,000** to be doubled. In whatever way God leads you to help we will be deeply grateful!

A New Chapter Begins in Missouri

This summer marked an exciting milestone for Shepherd's Canyon as we hosted our **first retreat** at our new Missouri location. And just in time—we have **waiting lists** of people who need help quickly! All of our Missouri and Arizona summer retreats filled completely. Opening a second location allows us to serve more people while making retreats more accessible to more people around the country. We are grateful to God for bringing this vision to life and grateful for everyone who has prayed, donated, volunteered, and encouraged us along the way.

we saw Him perform one! We had five short weeks to get our new site ready before the first retreat and we had LOTS of work to do! Ten volunteers joined Kevin and Tawn for a very productive weekend of work. The volunteers came from several communities, many after hearing about Shepherd's Canyon when Kevin and Tawn spoke at their churches:

- Zion Lutheran Church, Bethalto, Illinois: Steve, Nancy, Marla, and Cory
- Campus Lutheran Church, Columbia, Missouri: Lugine and Ron
- Immanuel Lutheran Church, Washington, Missouri: Katie and Kerry
- Trinity Lutheran Church, Edinburg, Illinois: Mark and Wanda

One project was assembling a dozen new counseling chairs to be used for group sessions with 8 more coming soon for small counseling rooms. We are grateful we could purchase these chairs with a generous \$12,000 grant from the Koskovich Foundation.

The volunteers helped move beds and large cabinets, pull old dishes out of cabinets before wiping them down and stocking them with clean dishes. They tore out the inflexible wooden shelves in the pantry area, put together food service shelves, and painted. They put together counseling chairs, an outdoor patio set, and more. Some made the place more beautiful by weeding, doing landscape work and weed whipping around the lake. A tree was trimmed and a small cedar tree removed. The porch was power washed and a cross and fire pit were built. Wow!

We are also thankful for Anne Larson, who has been a full-time volunteer at our Arizona site. Anne flew to Missouri and helped us prepare the new site, along with food service and hospitality during the retreat.

A tremendous amount of work was accomplished in a short time. God provided these helpers and we are so thankful for each volunteer who gave time, energy, and a servant heart to prepare this new location for ministry workers and their spouses! Praise God for people who say Yes!

One more thing...We Hate to Turn People Away

In recent months, we have heard from many pastors, missionaries, teachers, ministry leaders, and spouses who are struggling and urgently need help. While some are able to contribute the entire cost, most need financial help. The more people we help, the more scholarships we give and the more financial help we need.

-One Christian high school principal had recently resigned and was looking for a place to process this new situation.

-A teacher shared that she was deeply discouraged and questioning whether God still wanted her in her current calling. She found herself becoming frustrated with students, coworkers, and administrators more quickly than ever before.

-A pastor from Malaysia had submitted his resignation so he could rest and seek healing in mind, body, and spirit before returning to ministry.

-Another ministry worker described the constant pressure of ministry as overwhelming, who just simply wanted to breathe again.

-A pastor's wife contacted us because her husband, after 29 years of pastoral ministry, was experiencing significant burnout that was also deeply affecting their marriage. Shepherd's Canyon had been recommended as a place where they might begin rebuilding their relationship.

These are just a few examples of the requests we receive.

By God's grace, Shepherd's Canyon exists to provide professional Christian counseling, rest, renewal, and hope for ministry workers and their spouses. Yet the demand for retreats continues to exceed the number of spaces we currently have available.
