We even had a retired church worker come up to us and say that the Shepherd's Canyon Retreat program **SAVED HIS SON'S LIFE...and his son is still a pastor today!!**

During one of our retreats a guest wrapped herself in one of these quilts. She wore that beautiful quilt during all her sessions. It became a warm comfort to her.



That quilt was then given to her to take home as a reminder of God's love and comfort.

When it became apparent how much a comfort quilt would mean to our guests, the TLC Quilters from Algona, Iowa graciously gave Shepherd's Canyon many comfort quilts so that guests can take one home as a reminder of how deeply they are loved. Barb Bitterman, the leader of the TLC Quilters, says that each quilt comes with prayers and love. They pray over every quilt before it is sent out to go all over the world, bringing love and comfort to church workers in need. The fabrics are woven together in love just like the recipients of these quilts are woven together by the hand of God and the threads of their lives.

Kristi Goelke, who is in charge of hospitality at our Standing Stones site in Arizona says, "What a precious gift to remind them that there is love in Christ's family and that God makes all the pieces of our lives beautiful when He weaves them in His saving grace. He binds us together."

# From Hard Knocks to Standing Rocks – New Book

A new book is coming which tells the powerful true story of **Raine Selin**, head of maintenance, who has worked at Standing Stones for over 10 years. He & Kevin are writing a book about how he went from having a life sentence to having a life changed by God. This is a story of trauma, survival, transformation, faith, hope & love.

#### Here is a sneak peek of the book:

"We were barely holding it together. My wife and I had moved to Springfield, Oregon, hoping for a fresh start. New city, new job, clean slate. But addiction doesn't care about



zip codes. I got pulled back into the same crowd, the same drugs, the same darkness...That was 1987. That's when my world stopped. I was arrested. No trial could convince me I was wrong. I didn't care what the judge said or how many years they gave me. I knew what I did. I did it on purpose. I wasn't proud, but I wasn't sorry either...at least not back then. I was given a life sentence...At night, I'd lie in my bunk staring at the ceiling, replaying the moment by the river over and over. Wondering who I'd become. Wondering if redemption was even possible for someone like me."
